2. Candidate Forum for County Superintendent

Action Item: Approve Cradle to Career Sponsorship of Candidate Forum for County Superintendent

Kathy Goodacre discussed the opportunity for Cradle to Career to host and sponsor a Candidates Forum for County Superintendent. The primary would be held in June and a run-off, if needed, in November. Cradle to Career members agreed it was a great idea and it aligned with Cradle to Career's goals as it was an opportunity to educate the community. The following feedback was provided:

- Opportunity to collect input from the community beforehand and create questions for the candidates
- Timeline would be March early April
- Multi-lingual forum and include a good translator
- Filing deadline is mid-March
- Hybrid model The Teacher Learning Facility is available and has webcasting ability
- Create English and Spanish outreach material so community would understand the importance of their involvement
- We would want messaging to the community well in advance of this forum
- Get the Spanish-speaking community involved in this process as well as youth
