Portrait of a Graduate

Mickey Porter, from PlusONE Leadership consulting, was invited to work with the College and Career Readiness Taskforce. The initial objective of this taskforce was how to define college and career readiness in Sonoma County and how to measure success as a community.

This is the first attempt to do a county-wide portrait of a graduate. Kathy Goodacre explained how this model would be provided to the school districts for them to adopt. Some of the Sonoma County high schools are already looking into this model. Mickey presented on the Portrait of a Graduate model to the group (portraitofagraduate.org).

It was recommended to engage the community from the very beginning (teacher community, unions, chambers of commerce, service clubs, tribes...) in order to make this process efficient.
